A two day instruction and assessment course for the Paddle Australia (PA) Flatwater Guide Award.

Pre-requisite

- Flatwater (FW) paddling skills as explained in the **FW Skills Award**
- 5 or more FW trips plus 3 paddling activities as assistant plus 3 paddling activities as lead guide in the previous three years

This is not a skills development course. Candidates are expected to have paddling skill levels identified in the **FW Skills Award**.

This course will cover topics such as

- paddling guiding skills
- refining paddling technique
- rescues
- minimal impact practice
- interpreting weather and navigation
- trip intentions, float plans and risk management
- group management
